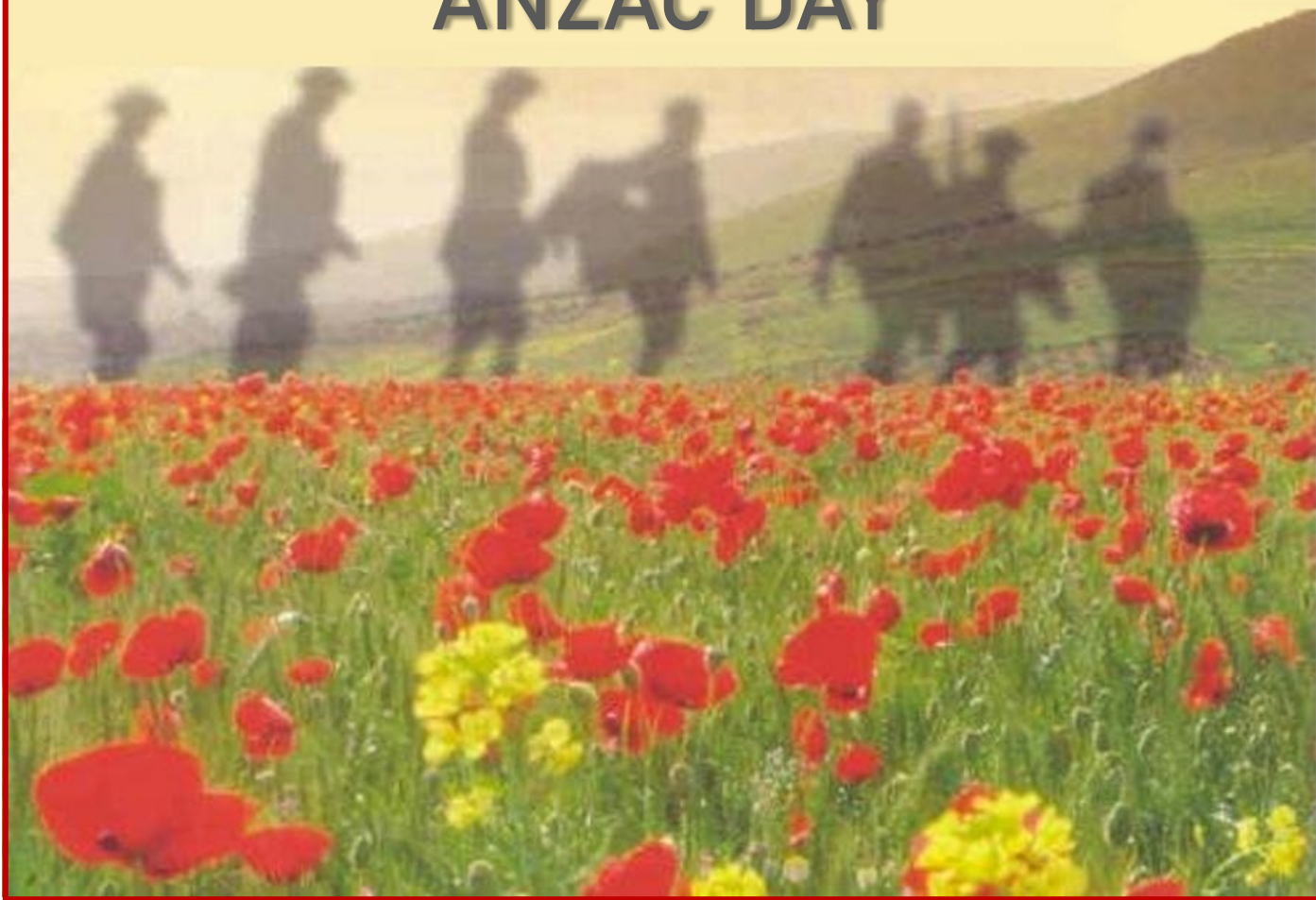

NEWS FROM THE FRONT!!

I feel like we are in a war zone against an unseen enemy. It is so important for us all to observe the rules of social distancing and only going out two at a time for essentials if we are to win the war!

As you know, the community hall is closed to all activities. However, I do have a bit of good news in this regard. Our lovely **Librarian, Keran Smee**, has offered to assist anyone who would like to borrow/return books, borrow puzzles or games. Keran is prepared to be contacted on **41258191** or mobile **0407456127**. She will allow access to the library one person at a time if you phone her to make an appointment – **between the hours of 9am to 5pm only please**. As books/games etc are returned they will be carefully sanitised to eliminate spread of disease but as an extra precaution please wear gloves when entering the library. Thank you Keran.

Well, the Local Government elections have come and gone. Our local Division 7 Councillor, Darren Everard has been returned with a very comfortable majority, so too has Mayor, George Seymour. Congratulations to both and to all other successful candidates.

ANZAC DAY Dawn Service has been cancelled. There is growing advocacy for people to go to their front gate to observe a minute's silence at 6am on ANZAC morning so if you feel like doing this, adhering to all social distancing rules of course, then please do. ABC radio will also be broadcasting a service I believe. Lest we forget!

We have been successful with two out of three applications for grant funding from the Community Gambling Fund. The Tourist Radio has been awarded \$8,500 for additional equipment and the Reserve Sub-Committee has been awarded \$15,000 to complete the canteen at the Reserve. What we need now are more sporting teams to utilise the Reserve facilities! To this end, we were meeting with Council but unfortunately had to cancel the meeting due to the current crisis. The most important application of all was not successful – a grant to install solar power at the hall. This is the third time we have been knocked back on a grant for this but we will keep trying. Once we get solar power, we can go full steam ahead to aircon the hall.

Our Webmaster, Adam Cork, has been working hard to transfer our website to a new server, given that the existing one had been disabled by the provider, Made Neat. Thank you Adam.

The secret to 'perfect peace' lies in this Scripture:

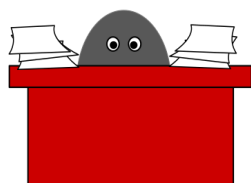

Pharmacy Update : COVID-19

April 2020

Easier Home Delivery Ordering

The government is now paying me to deliver to you if you meet certain criteria, so please do not hesitate to ask for home deliveries. Please visit the [MedAdvisor website](#) on your computer or smartphone/tablet and create an account. Once you have completed setting up your account, you will be able to add River Heads Pharmacy as "your pharmacy" send me photos of your prescriptions for home delivery with no extra fee.

Hand Sanitiser

I have been very busy the last week applying for permits to brew, distill and store alcohol for making hand sanitiser. So far I have spent close to \$13,000 on materials, equipment and staff wages getting things in order. My bottles for filling are still on their way to me (estimated arrival 1st April), but in the meantime, if you want some please bring a PUMP SPRAY bottle similar to Aerogard. This is a liquid not a gel, so a soap/sunscreen type pump bottle will waste too much... At the moment (until supplies grow) I can offer only 100ml (about 2 month supply if sprayed ~20 times a day) for \$25.

Medicine Availability

You may have heard some people say there are shortages, but the joy of being a quieter pharmacy is that I can control who gets your medicine. At the moment all pharmacies are under directions to limit dispensing to ONE MONTH SUPPLY. If everyone can follow directions to CEASE ALL UNNECESSARY movements, you'll restrict the chance of you touching anything that an infected person has touched (door handles, public bathroom tap handles etc...)

Extra staff

With the spike in locals using my pharmacy for deliveries I have employed Francis "Frankie" to work every day. Please call in and she will answer the phone and take your order :)

Please LISTEN to professional advice and AVOID all unnecessary movements.

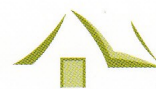

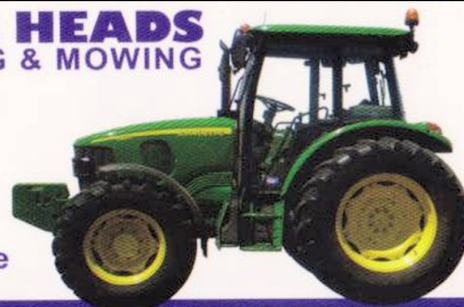

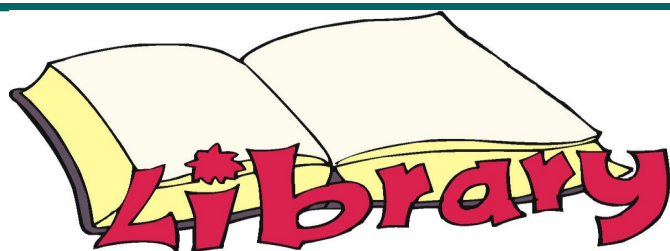
