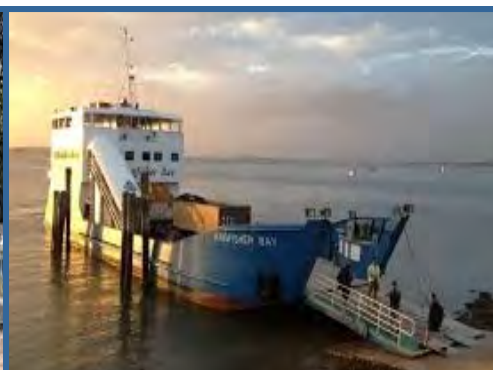

There is still a lot going at Council, with several big projects about to start across our region.

I am asking residents from River Heads and Booral to have their say on how Council should respond to the current and future impacts of coastal hazards such as tidal surge and erosion.

**Coastal Futures** - Planning Our Changing Coastline project has entered the next stage with the release of new online surveys and we need your assistance with the next stage of this vital project.

This project aims to determine how our community can become more resilient to the effects of hazards such as storm tides, inundation and coastal erosion and we are now seeking residents' feedback on options and ideas to respond to coastal hazards.

Feedback received will be considered along with technical and financial information so that we can shape a long term Coastal Futures strategy that helps us to maintain the unique environment and lifestyle on the Fraser Coast.

### **Reporting Issues to Council:**

Just a little reminder of the **Snap Send Solve** Service Council is using now. I must say it is of great assistance on the reporting of matters to Council.

Very simple to use (once installed and you have created an account):

1. *Open the app and take a photo of the matter you want to report*
2. *Select the location (it will do this for you, it just needs you to confirm it)*
3. *Select the type of incident*
4. *Add a comment about the matter*

*Hit submit.*

Once submitted, you will receive a confirmation email of the matter and the matter will be attended to by Council officers.

All Fraser Coast residents and visitors are encouraged to report issues with trees, pavement problems, graffiti, dumped rubbish, broken streetlights, water faults or any areas of concern in the local community.

The Snap Send Solve app is easy to use, and sending a report takes less than 30 seconds!  
Download the app on your smart device and start reporting!

Until next month - may your lines be tight, knots strong and hooks sharp.

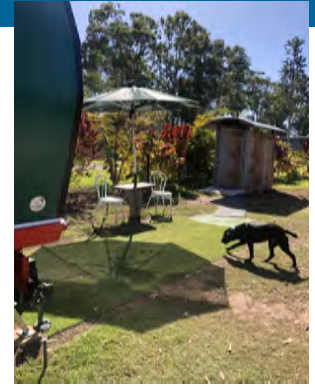
