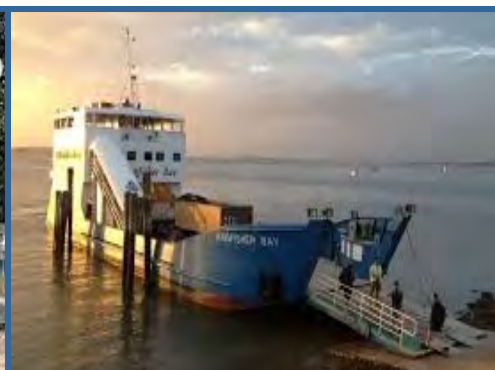

We owe a huge vote of thanks to our River Heads Action Group under chairmanship of Malcolm Herbert for the wonderful and painstaking effort put in over seven years to achieve the Federal Government's non-approval of the proposed Turtle Cove Development. As I have said many times before, we are not against progress, otherwise we shouldn't represent ourselves as a 'progress' association. But any progress must be sensible and sustainable given the unique ecological aspects of this beautiful area we live in. The Federal Government ruled that the development would have jeopardised the ecology of the area which is classed as having High Ecological Values (HEV), in particular, the roosting areas of the endangered Eastern Curlew bird species. It is a real win for people power and a signal for the future that our unique environment must and will be protected. Thank you to all who put in such a monumental effort.

Sorry to say our Vice President, Margaret Horlock, has sustained shoulder and wrist injuries as a result of a cycling accident. After spending several days in hospital, Margaret is home and on the mend. We wish her a speedy recovery from these nasty injuries.

**Notice to all hall activities:** We are now required to fill in separate forms for all people attending the hall. ### EPBC refusal protects migratory birds

I have moved to protect one of Australia's critically endangered migratory birds, the Eastern Curlew, by refusing a development proposal under the Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act.

Anscape Pty Ltd had referred plans to construct and operate the Turtle Cove Haven Retirement Village and related infrastructure, at River Heads near Queensland's Hervey Bay.

After visiting the site and reviewing a thorough Departmental assessment, that included significant public consultation, I have accepted the Department's recommendation that the proposal be refused considering its likely adverse impact on the Eastern Curlew and the Great Sandy Straits Ramsar site.

It has been determined that the development would have presented an unacceptable risk to important roosting habitat for the critically endangered Eastern Curlew in an area which regularly supports ecologically significant proportions of its global population.

The Great Sandy Strait is a sand passage estuary between mainland Australia and Fraser Island, and one of only 66 internationally sanctioned Ramsar sites in Australia.

The Great Sandy Straits area is also important as a roosting and foraging ground for migratory shorebirds and hosts many species of fish, crustaceans, oysters, turtles, Dugongs, dolphins and whales.

The decision ends seven years of uncertainty in relation to the site and underlines our commitment to strong environmental protection.

It also reinforces our ongoing international commitment to the protection of migratory shore birds.

For more than 40 years, Australia has played an important role in international cooperation to conserve migratory birds in the East Asian – Australasian Flyway.

The government recognises that the conservation of important sites, both within Australia and along their migration routes, is essential to their survival.

Australia continues to work closely with regional neighbours and the state and territories to protect migratory birds and their habitats.

The refusal follows Australia's contribution last year at the World Heritage Committee meeting in Azerbaijan, when Australia played a key role in securing the World-Heritage listing of two critical migratory bird sanctuaries in China's territory in the Yellow Sea.

Spring already!

Not sure what has happened to the year, but it is September already!

There is still a lot going at Council, with several big projects about to start across our region.

I will start off this month with a thank you to those who have reported illegal dumping in the area and also the rubbish along Booral Rd.

As an example for the whole of the Fraser Coast in July 29 cases of illegal dumping were received and reported, with fines issued and more on the way!

If you do come across illegal dumping please report it to Council's Call Centre on 1300 79 49 29 or via email to [enquiry@frasercoast.qld.gov.au](mailto:enquiry@frasercoast.qld.gov.au) as soon as possible so it can be removed.

In relation to the rubbish on Booral Road, as this is a State Road it is traditionally cleaned by Department of Transport and Main Roads on a fortnightly run. I have been advised that funding has been reduced and therefore this will not be happening as often as previously scheduled. I will be writing to the Minister seeking clarification on this matter as I do not think it is acceptable.

For your information I have included a list of local State Roads which are managed by TMR. If you have any future concerns in regards to roadside litter on State controlled road networks, could I please ask that you contact TMR directly. Their website address is <https://www.tmr.qld.gov.au/> and contact phone number is 13 23 80.

### **State controlled road networks:**

- Boat Harbour Drive (starting from roundabout at Elizabeth Street intersection)
- Booral Road
- Elizabeth Street (from Boat Harbour Drive to Boundary Road)
- Maryborough Hervey Bay Road
- Pialba Burrum Heads Road
- Torbanlea / Burrum Heads Road
- Torbanlea Pialba Road / Torbanlea Road

### **Reporting Issues to Council:**

Thank you to those who have used the Snap Send Solve Service, and a reminder of the Snap Send Solve Service Council is using now. I must say I am using it more and more!

Very simple to use (once installed and you have created an account):

1. Open the app and take a photo of the matter you want to report
2. Select the location (it will do this for you, it just needs you to confirm it)
3. Select the type of incident
4. Add a comment about the matter

Hit submit.

Once submitted, you will receive a confirmation email of the matter and the matter will be attended to by Council officers.

The Snap Send Solve app is easy to use, and sending a report takes less than 30 seconds!

The older we get, the more experience of life we have. And the more we begin to realise what the really important things are. As we face trials and troubles, we should be maturing in wisdom and growing in patience. Our problems might not have changed, but our perspective should have.

Instead of worrying, we can be like Joseph, who went from being wrongfully imprisoned to become Pharaoh's Prime Minister in Egypt (in the Old Testament of the Bible). He could look back on experiences that he thought he'd never get through, and say to the opposition *'You meant evil against me, but God meant it for good.'* (Genesis 50:20 NASB). The "good" in his case was a supply of food for Egypt and all the surrounding countries stricken by famine for seven years.

Instead of complaining with anger and bitterness, and only making the problem worse and robbing us of joy, we can look to see God's hand at work and say: *'His grace is sufficient.'* (See 2 Corinthians 12:9).

The word for today is—God wants you to become more patient! Patience is one of the fruits of the Spirit. But it's a very slow-growing fruit that thrives best in the soil of troubles and trials. Some of us are like the lady who prayed, *'Lord, give me patience, and I want it right now.'*

In the New Testament it says: *'When your faith is tested, your endurance has a chance to grow. So let it grow, for when your endurance is fully developed, you will be perfect and complete.'* (James 1:3–4 NLT)

When you think about it, patience is simply trusting God with things like 'how' and 'why' and 'when'. As you look back on some of the things you wanted so badly, you realise God kept you from getting into some major messes. Impatience is one of the dominant characteristics of children; it's spiritual immaturity.

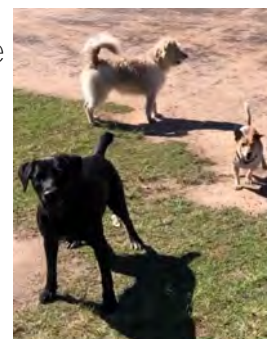


Fraser Coast RV PARK is now even more pet friendly having introduced Doggy Daycare to customers visiting the park.

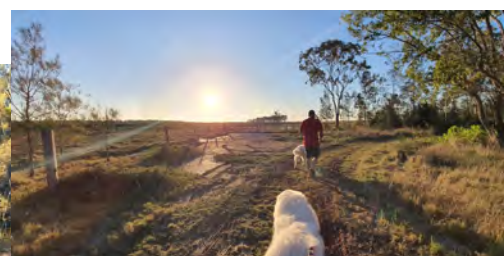
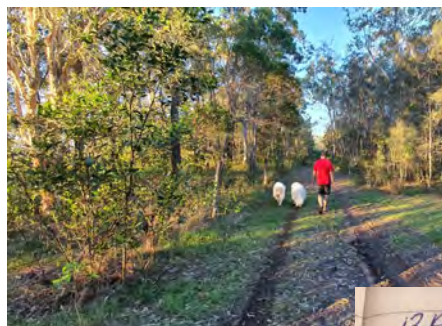

### Pharmacist Advice Column - Allergic Rhinitis

Allergic rhinitis or "hay fever" is the most common chronic respiratory condition in Australia, affecting almost one in five people. Children are less likely to have allergic rhinitis (10 per cent) compared with all other groups. The goal of allergic rhinitis management is to achieve optimal symptom control and improve quality of life.

**CAUSES:** Allergic rhinitis is a nasal membrane "reaction" to allergen exposure. Common triggers include dust mite, animal fur, pollens, mould spores and other air pollutants.

**TREATMENTS:** Although there is no cure, optimal control is achieved by allergen avoidance. Non-medical treatments include nasal flush or saline spray. If symptoms persist, Mark can recommend some antihistamines or nasal sprays to help calm your symptoms.

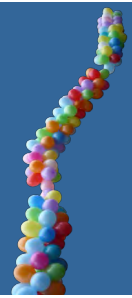
